It is very important that you submit a complete application, or you will not be considered for the scholarship. Middle school students are strongly encouraged to apply. Don't be intimidated by the questions asked. Your age will be considered when reviewing your application.

Important: All documents listed must be submitted for your application to be considered.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Complete application (pages 2-5 of this document). All questions must be answered completely and within the word limit. All information that you supply is held in a confidential nature and all applications are shredded at the end of the process to ensure confidentiality.
- 2. At least two letters of recommendation, including,
 - a. One from a teacher or member of the faculty at your school; and
 - b. One from another adult not related to you (friend, clergy, doctor, etc.)
 - c. Up to four letters will be considered. Letters should be sent directly from the person writing them to scholarships@scubanautsintl.org with your name in the subject line.
- 3. Resume that provides information related to school, community, or other activities in which you have participated, class work you feel is related to SCUBAnauts, and awards or recognitions received. If you've never written a resume, here's a good place to get you started: https://www.cappex.com/articles/applications/high-school-resume-step-by-step. It should only be one page long.

Candidates that make it through the initial screening will be asked to provide proof of household income and required to participate in a personal interview. Interviews will be scheduled through the applicant's parent/guardian or listed adult sponsor.

Candidates must pass the dive physical and swim test prior to a final scholarship offer.
